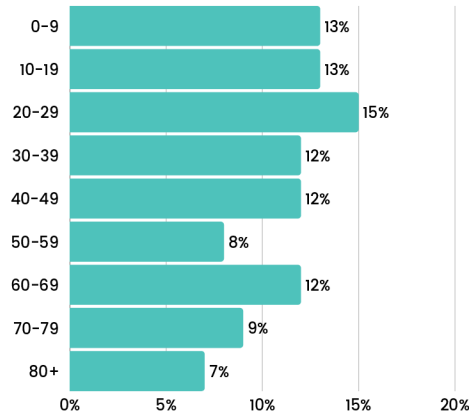

Age Population

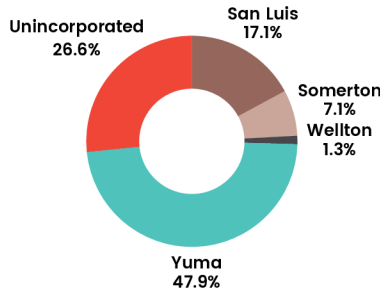
Yuma County's median age is lower than the state and national average, despite being home to a growing population of retirees in Arizona.

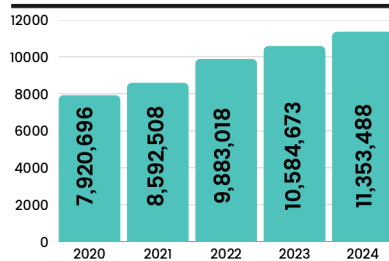
